The Jaap Kunst Collection, managed by the University of Amsterdam, is a sound archive that encompasses recordings, photographs, silent films, and correspondences collected by the Dutch ethnomusicologist Jaap Kunst (1893-1960). This collection allows us to imagine how the Indonesian archipelago sounded to the Dutch ethnomusicologist during colonial times.

This website is part of the Decolonising Southeast Asian Sound Archives (DeSASA) project (2021-2024) which aims to "refresh" metadata by adding new descriptive terms, making items more searchable with additional names and locations, and other factors. This project of potential decolonization will be slow, gradual, and will be executed with great care.
